WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF CANDLES IN THE CHURCH?

Candles are used in several ways in the Church. The primary reason for them is that their light reminds us that Jesus Christ is the Light of the world, who delivers us from the darkness of sin and death. The most important candle in the church is the one that perpetually burns on the altar in front of the Tabernacle that holds the reserved Body and Blood of Christ.

This leads to a second meaning of candles. Burning a candle in front of something is a way of showing honor to that object. Thus---the candle on the altar; candles before icons, processional candles carried by altar boys before the Gospel book in Little Entrance, and before the Gifts in the Great Entrance.

A third use of candles when we light a candle when we enter the church as a way to pray for someone. Lighting a candle is not a magical substitute for praying with our words or thoughts. Rather, it is a way of physically expressing the prayer we are saying. By leaving a candle in the church to burn throughout the week, we are physically expressing our intent to pray for that person or intention not only on Sunday but through the week as well.

A final note---some of the church candles are changed in color during the various seasons of the Church Year to help us to remember what we are commemorating at that time. For example, we use purple in Lent and white at Pascha.
